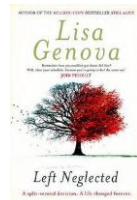
After a decade of trying to fall pregnant, Zoe Baxter's life is turned upside down with loss and divorce.

(Lisa Genova)

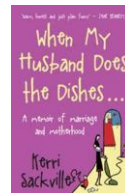
Sarah Nickerson suffers a traumatic head injury where she loses the left side of space.
