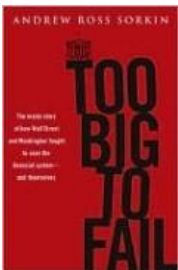
Newsletter: September 2011

KYLIE LADD



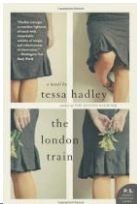
